Residents can access the free NHS funded service through their family doctor.


There are a number of benefits to residents in having a hearing test in a familiar setting:


You may notice that a resident is struggling in group situations such as watching TV in the lounge.

Your resident's GP will carry out a consultation that may include a preliminary investigation.



The resident's GP will offer a choice of local providers who can arrange a domiciliary visit at a time convenient to you.



A hearing aid audiologist will then conduct a full assessment and hearing test with your resident and if required supply and fit a new hearing device.



With improved hearing your resident will re-engage in normal day to day activity in group situations and to enjoy a fuller life.

How do I know I am choosing a safe provider for my resident?

All providers working under AQP have to pass a rigorous qualification process to ensure they meet the appropriate quality requirements.

Will I or my resident have to pay?

Whether your chosen provider is NHS, voluntary organisation or private sector, your resident's care will still be funded by the NHS, so no extra charges will apply.

Will my treatment cost the NHS more depending on who I choose?

No. All providers in the area will be paid the same agreed price. They have to compete on the quality of their service, not how cheaply they can provide it.

Where does The Outside Clinic cover?

Currently The Outside Clinic is delivering this exciting service to 80% of all the CCGs who have chosen to offer adult hearing as an AQP service.
